The Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) of Kay County, Oklahoma, met in special session at 8:45 o'clock a.m. on Monday, April 8 the meeting was posted for public information on March 20, 2019, at 12:00 p.m. at the Courthouse front door, Commissioners Court, and basement handicapped entrance of the Kay County Courthouse in Newkirk, Oklahoma.

Chairman Jack Godberson called the meeting to order. Those present were as follows: John A. Wilson, Member (8:48 a.m.); Jason Shanks, Member; Kay County Assessor Susan Keen and Janell Leaming, First Deputy Assessor; Kay County Sheriff Steve Kelley; Kay County Treasurer Christy Kennedy; Dennis Bonewell, Emergency Management Director; Frank Cain, Jay Fagan, Terry Willets, Carol Morgan, Newkirk; Jonathan McDaniels, Donna and Monte Stucky; Cody Griesel, Ponca City News; Claude Williams, Taxpayers for Transparency; Tammy Reese, Secretary/Kay County Clerk. Member Jason Shanks led the Flag Salute.

Hearing to protest or support a Petition to vacate a certain portion of "O" Road lying between Indian Road and Home Road in Kay County: Jonathan McDaniels was the first to speak; he stated he is in favor of the Petition as the road has been closed since 1994. He said he has obtained two (2) easements.

Donna Stucky said she is against the Petition and stated she would like the road kept open. She mentioned she and her husband had a nearby farm and they could use the road to go from one field to the other. Ms. Stucky said they currently use the road.

Commissioner Shanks said the county is not going to open the road up again and told the road is not on the county inventory to maintain.

Discussion continued regarding the road, ability to build fence and put up cattle panels, location and road specifics.

Commissioner Shanks reiterated the county will not be opening the road; he also said he would speak to land owners regarding if gates can be put up allowing the Stucky's to move from field to field in that area.

No action was taken to vacate a certain portion of "O" Road lying between Indian Road and Home Road in Kay County.

There being no other business, motion was made by Shanks and seconded by Godberson to adjourn, 8:55 a.m. Motion carried: Godberson, aye; Wilson, aye; Shanks, aye.
