The Kay County Excise Board met in special session at 11:00 o'clock a.m. on Friday, October 29, 2021 in the Commissioners Court on the first floor of the Kay County Courthouse in Newkirk, Oklahoma. Notice of the meeting was posted on October 26, 2021, at 10:30 a.m. on the Courthouse front door, Commissioners Court, and basement handicapped entrance of the Kay County Courthouse in Newkirk, Oklahoma, and Kay County Website.

Chairman J.C. Estes called the meeting to order. Members: Steve Austin, Vice-Chairman, present; Joe R. Cary, Member, absent. Other's present were as follows: Claude Williams, Taxpayers for Transparency; Tammy Reese, Secretary/Kay County Clerk.

Motion was made by Austin and seconded by Estes approving signing the 2021/2022 Estimate of Needs and Financial Statement of the Fiscal Year 2020-2021, Sinking Fund Schedules June 30, 2021 and Sinking Fund Estimate of Needs for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2022 for Kay County, Kay County Health Department and Kay County Cities/Schools. Reese explained the delay in receiving budgets were due to changes in reporting; she said this is the first year all counties are under the chart of accounts and all budget makers had to receive special training in methods of reporting. Reese said Kay County was a beta test county with the chart of accounts back in 2015 and recently all counties are currently uniform. Reese told all employees paid under the general government fund were receiving a cost-of-living increase of \$100 per month beginning in November; under the calculation of annual county officer salary statute the officers were allowed a \$107 monthly increase beginning in November. Motion carried: Estes, aye; Austin, aye.

Motion was made by Austin and seconded by Estes to adjourn (11:33 a.m.). Motion carried: Estes, aye; Austin, aye.
